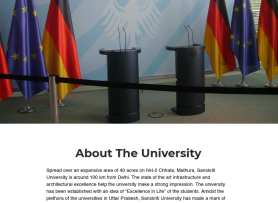


# School of Humanities & Social Science

## Charges

**Caution Money** - Rs. 5,000/- in the first year of the course (refundable on successful completion of the course & production of original receipt)

- Rs. 1,000/- extra will be charged in the first year as Alumni Association Fee. - Medical Insurance Fee extra - Washing Charges extra

- Miscellaneous Charges (Fitness Centre, Insurance etc)

**Hostel Fee** Will be as follows:

Room Charges - Rs. 55,000/- per annum (for double AC) - Rs. 45,000/- per annum (for triple AC) - Rs. 30,000/- per annum (for triple occupancy) - Rs. 40,000/- per annum (for double occupancy) - Rs. 25,000/- per annum (for six seated room- only for Diploma Courses)

If any student stays during vacations, has to pay Hostel Rent Rs. 5000/- per month

- Hostel Security - Rs 5000/- in the first year of the course. (Refundable on vacating the hostel on successful completion of the course).

- Rooms in hostel will be allotted on first - come - first serve basis. - UGC norms will be adhered to fee refund.

**Books Charges** - Rs. 25,000/- per annum

The Prospectus along with admission form can be obtained by paying INR 1,000/- in cash or through post by sending Demand Draft of INR 1,000/- in favor of Sanskriti University payable at Mathura.

## Admissions Procedure

1. (a) The Candidate registered for a particular programme shall be sent an offer letter normally from April onwards.

(b) Candidate who have appeared in SEEE (Sanskriti Engineering Entrance Examination) will be sent offer letter after the declaration of SEEE result depending upon their rank, choice of programme & availability of seats.

2. Candidate will normally be given 15 days time to deposit the first instalment of Fees.

3. Candidate will be required to report at any of the following places:

- (a) At the Regional Centre at which they have registered.
- (b) At the Sanskriti University, Chhata, Mathura Campus.

4. Candidate at the time of reporting should bring the following documents:

- (a) A Bank Draft of the amount indicated in the offer letter as first instalment.
- (b) Application Form duly filled in & signed by Candidate & Parent.
- (c) Copy of Admit Card for SEEE, if application & appeared.
- (d) Proof of Date of Birth.
- (e) Certificate and Mark sheet of 10th & 12th Examinations.
- (f) Certificate and Mark sheet of Graduation/Post Graduation, if applicable.
- (g) Migration/Transfer Certificate.
- (h) Conduct and Character Certificate from head of the Institution from where the qualifying exam passed.
- (i) Medical Fitness Certificate to be signed by a Registered Medical Practitioner holding a degree not lower than MBBS or equivalent.
- (j) Aadhar Card.

All Original document for verification & three Sets of Photo copies of all the above Documents.

(k) Passport size photos-Aplicant (10)

(l) Passport size photos-Parents (5-6)

(m) An undertaking on the prescribed form attached with the Prospectus, in case the result of qualifying examination has not been declared, duly signed by Application & Parent.

5. On submission of the first instalment of fees and verification of documents in regard to fulfillment of eligibility conditions, the student will be given Provisional admission in the programme applied.

6. Candidate will be subsequently advised to report to the University on the day of commencement of the session for orientation, programme/course registration, when the teaching will commence.

The Candidate will be required to deposit the balance fees before being allowed to register and attend classes.

7. The candidate at the time of registration/orientation will bring two undertakings which are signed by him/ her and signed by his/her parent. The format of undertaking have to be downloaded from website <http://www.sanskriti.edu.in>.

8. Candidate will be required to deposit the balance fee before being allowed to register & attend classes.

9. Fee Payment Schedule: 30th November for Even Semester starting in January 30th April for Odd Semester starting in July.
