Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the **Sanskriti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital at 28 K.M. Stone, Mathura – Delhi Highway, Chhata, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2018-19– **reg.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. F.No.R.12011/40/2016-EP (IM-1) dated 22.09.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating to develop the requisite infrastructure for 2<sup>nd</sup> Professional for consideration of the case for the 2018-19 session.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 26.02.2018 and re-visited on 25-26.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the consent of affiliation, computerized central registration system for IPD, Web based computerized central registration system, required number of hospital staff, Lecturer in Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta, Quality testing laboratory, Functional Operation Theatre, conduction of deliveries, Functional Clinical Laboratory, X-ray, ECG & USG, Computer & Printer in some departments, Functional college website and Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff were not available in the college hospital. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 21.08.2018 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, and as per approved

Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs), it is found that College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS) course.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to **grant conditional permission** to the ***Sanskriti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital at 28 K.M. Stone, Mathura – Delhi Highway, Chhata, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh*** to take admissions for **100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018:

- i. Computerised Central Registration System in the Hospital.
- ii. Required number of Hospital Staffs as per RMS, 2016.
- iii. Functional Operation Theatre in the Hospital.
- iv. Functional Clinical Laboratory, X-Ray and ECG in Hospital.
- v. Functional Website of the College.
- vi. Computer & Printers in the concerned departments.
- vii. Functional Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff and hospital staff.
- viii. Functional Web linked/based computerized central registration system for OPD/IPD patients.
- ix. Conduction of deliveries.
- x. Functional USG facility and Quality testing laboratory.

5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and Regulation 10 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*,

6. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.

7. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
