

## Hostel Rules for Hostlers

- Students must occupy rooms specifically allotted to them. They are not allowed to change rooms except with the written permission of the Warden/ Chief Warden. However, students can choose their room-mates as per their choice within first few days, and duly inform their Hostel Warden.
- Change of accommodation from one hostel to another during a term is generally not permitted.
- The Chief Warden reserves the right to break open rooms in case of any violation of hostel rules, suspected unlawful activities or on a perceived security risk.
- Rooms allotted to the students at the time of admission are for a limited period of up to one year or less.
- Residents who wish to vacate the hostel must meet the caretaker for necessary formalities. Permission of the students' parents and HOIs along with certain documentation is mandatory.
- Cooking in hostel rooms is not permitted.
- No private vehicles are permitted in the hostel.
- The hostel facility is open to only regular students who are on roll of the Institute.
- No Hosteller (boys) is allowed to stay outside after 7:30 pm. Any deviation will be permitted only after obtaining prior permission on written application to the warden.
- Hosteller returning late to their Hostels will be fined Rs.200/- per day.
- No Hosteller of the girls' hostel is allowed to stay outside the campus after 7:00 PM (summer) /6:00 PM (Winter). Visitors will not be allowed to meet the Hostellers of girls' hostel without proper permission of the warden.
- Hostellers must look up the Hostel Notice Board twice a day, as important notices are displayed from time to time.
- All cases of illness should be reported to the Hostel warden.
- No student should keep any Fire-arms, lethal weapons, poisonous things, intoxicants or drugs of any kind in the hostel and a boarder found guilty of having committed a breach of this rule, shall be liable to be expelled from the hostel, apart from any other punishment that may be awarded depending upon the gravity of each case, by the Discipline Committee of the University.
- Hostellers are responsible for the safe keeping of their personal belongings and hostel authorities are not responsible for any loss / Damage.
- If any Hosteller found involved in any indisciplinary activity, a fine of Rs.25000/shall be imposed.
- Illtreating or abusing the hostel employees and/or canteen staff is strictly prohibited. If anybody found doing so, fine of Rs.25000/shall be imposed.
- In case of any complaint against mess/hostel employees, it should be report to hostel warden immediately.
- Nobody is expected to call Dial 100 (Police) until permitted by the authorities otherwise calling police in the hostel may lead to strict action and a fine of Rs. 25000/as well.
- Students shall not bring, consonance and /or drink any alcohol/Intoxicating drink, drugs or substance of any kind whatsoever and/or smoke in the room and/or any part of the campus premises. Any such incidence shall invite strict disciplinary action (Fine of Rs.25000/) leading to expulsion from the hostel.
- Any student making false ragging complaint, he/she may face disciplinary action with a fine of Rs. 50000/as per university rules.
- Use of electric heater, electric rod and other similar appliances is strictly prohibited.
- For A.C. Rooms, separate meters will be installed. Every month 500 units will be free for a particular room and after that, Rs. 12/per unit will be charged on monthly basis.
- No hosteller is allowed to vacate the hostel during midsemester. If anybody vacates, he/she will be charged full year hostel fees.
