### **Regulations for Scholarships**

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### **Regulations for Scholarships**

#### **1. Introduction and Title**

The regulations pertaining to the scholarships for students will be termed as "Regulations for Scholarships, Medals, Awards, and Special Awards". This regulation will govern all issues related to students' scholarships and allied issues.

#### 2. Approval by Competent Authority

The Competent Authority of Sanskriti University has resolved to approve the "Regulations for Scholarships, Medals, Awards, and Special Awards".

#### 3. Date of Effect

This regulation shall come in force with effect from the date of approval by the competent authority of Sanskriti University.

#### 4. Scholarships

The scholarships referred in these regulations shall be meant for the students taking fresh admission in full time programmes of Sanskriti University. This shall not be applicable to any other mode of learning.

#### 5. Admission Merit-Scholarship

Sanskriti University is offering Merit Scholarship to the bright students with a mission to attract students of high caliber and talent. The merit of the students shall be based on their marks obtained in the qualifying examination for the programme in which they are seeking admission. The students shall be required to comply with the various terms and conditions mentioned in the Admission Advertisement issued from time to time.

#### a) Grant of On Admission Merit-Scholarship:

The On Admission Merit Scholarship shall be given to the students on the basis of terms and conditions mentioned in the Admission Advertisement issued from time to time.

#### b) Scholarship Value:

The Scholarship value / amount in INR shall be 100%/50%/25% /other value depending on the marks obtained by the student in the qualifying examination for admission in the respective Diploma / UG / PG programmes of the University.

100 % Merit Scholarships will be named as "Chancellor's Scholarships – Sanskriti University".

#### **Grant of Scholarship**

The Grant of Scholarship will be governed by the rules and regulations pertaining to admission as prescribed by the Admission Department which is subject to change from time to time. The admission guidelines and related conditions for grant of scholarship are subject to change in academic session at the sole discretion of Admission Department.

#### 6. Mandatory Conditions for Granting On Admission Scholarship

Mandatory Conditions to be fulfilled for Granting On Admission Scholarship

The student should have passed in all the subjects
• The aggregate of all marks scored in class XII /10+2/ Equivalent is to be taken after excluding Physical Education, Performing Arts, Fine Arts, and Vocational & Non-Written Subjects.
• The student should have scored aggregate marks as per the eligibility.
The candidate should have appeared in class XII examinations.
• Sanskriti University reserves the rights to withdraw/cancel the scholarship awarded if the student is found ineligible at any time in future.
<ul> <li>The student should not have improved his /her marks in any subject by appearing for improvement /supplementary examination in the same / succeeding year of passing class XII/10+2/Equivalent.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>For Boards with non-semester system for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> (i.e. combined mark sheet for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>), only 12<sup>th</sup> Marks along with practical Marks will be considered for Under Graduate Scholarship.</li> </ul>
• The Under Graduate Scholarships shall be based on CBSE /ICSE / State Boards only.

#### 7. Procedure for Grant of On Admission Scholarship

This scholarship shall be granted at the time of admission. The admission department will obtain prior sanction of the competent authority for grant of scholarship under the category. The admission department will also take approval of prescribed level of marks /percentage of marks /grade/percentile for granting the scholarship. The admission department shall be responsible to verify the mark sheets of the applicants and verify the mark sheets by checking the original mark sheets and shall ascertain the category under which a student falls / is eligible for scholarship.

#### 8. Withdrawal of On Admission Merit-Scholarship

The Scholarship shall be withdrawn at any time during a programme, from the date as approved by the Vice-Chancellor, under the following conditions:

- a. The student is not able to secure a rank / required CGPA in the batch of the programme as given in the admission notification for the concerned batch.
- b. The student is not able to pass all the examinations in the first attempt in the normal examination scheduled for his /her programme.
- c. The student is found to have adopted unfair means in examinations or has been debarred from appearing in the examinations.

- d. During the currency of the scholarship, the Dean of the School / Head of the Department reports that the student has been charged with misconduct, misbehavior, gross indiscipline, incident of ragging, use of drugs, or narcotics etc. and such misconduct is established.
- e. The Vice-Chancellor may however review such withdrawal in exceptional cases.

#### 8. Continuation of On Admission Merit-Scholarship

- a. At the end of each year of the programme, a student will continue to be eligible for scholarship on fulfillment of criteria mentioned in the admission notification.
- b. At the end of a year, if the student is not able to maintain the required rank / CGPA in the batch to be eligible for the scholarship amount granted at the time of admissions, the student will be eligible for the lower scholarship amount (if available) for the following year, subject to fulfillment of other conditions laid down under these regulations. Such student may again on improvement of the performance at the end of the subsequent year, become eligible for the original scholarship amount granted at the time of admission.
- c. A student will however, not be eligible for a higher amount than what has been granted at the time of admissions even if the performance is better than the required for the original scholarship amount.

#### 9. Rules and Regulations for Grant of Continuation Scholarship

The guidelines followed for grant of Continuation Scholarship for current academic year are as given below:

In case, any false & misleading information is given, a strict action will be taken against the student and concerned officials.

#### **10. Scholarship Award Committee**

The composition of the Scholarship Award Committee will be as under:

- i) Nominee of the Chancellor Chairperson
- ii) Vice-Chancellor /Pro-Vice Chancellor
- iii) Registrar
- iv) One of the Deans nominated by the VC
- v) Dean of Students Welfare
- vi) Finance Officer
- vii) The committee may invite any other faculty /officer to be part of the committee as special invitee.

Committee Members' Name and contact details should be displayed prominently on the notice board or any other suitable location to make sure that the information is available at all times. Also the deadlines to submit the documents should be mentioned on the notice board.

- A) The tenure of membership of the Scholarship Award Committee will be three years.
- B) The recommendations of the Scholarship Award Committee shall be placed before the Competent Authority for Approval.
- C) The approval for grant /renewal of the scholarship or otherwise will be communicated by the Registrar to the concerned Dean/HoD, the Finance Officer and the Controller of Examinations.

#### **General Conditions**

- 1. The Scholarship Award Committee shall be constituted by the Vice-chancellor.
- 2. If a student has decided to forego the Merit Scholarship, same shall not be offered to the next student.
- 3. If any student is eligible / entitled for more than one scholarship /concession, he/she has to make a choice for any one scholarship only.
- 4. A student if declared successful with moderation marks, will be eligible for scholarship provided he/she fulfills all the eligibility criteria for continuation of Scholarship.
- 5. The amount of scholarship may be payable to the student or may even be adjustable against the tuition fee and other charges, if any, due and payable by him to the University.
- 6. The rules and regulations can be changed by the senior management of the university and the same shall be binding on all the students with immediate effect.
- 7. The students are required to fill the Scholarship Application in a separate prescribed format and attach the required documents for consideration by the scholarship committee.
- 8. In case of any dispute, the court of Jurisdiction shall be Mathura only.
