NOTICE

This is to inform you all that Sanskriti University strictly introduced 75% compulsory attendance in all the courses and was implemented in the letter and spirit from final examinations of 2022-23. Awareness was created among the students of the importance of attending classes regularly. In spite of hectic efforts by the university, many students took it lightly and could not qualify for writing the End Semester Examinations which started 9th May, 2023. It was made clear to the students that the university will offer courses in the condensed semester starting 01/06/2023 for a period of nearly one month to make up for the lost classes and examinations will be conducted subsequently for the students who could not fulfill 60% attendance and could not write final examinations. In order to facilitate this, the university has taken the following decisions.

1. Students have to **Register** only for those courses in which they could not attend 60% of classes on **01/06/2023** with the respective Deans of Schools.
2. Regular classes will commence from **02/06/2023** and the students have to attend **minimum 80%** of the classes conducted during the condensed semester, failing which they will not be allowed to write the examinations again and they have to repeat the courses with the juniors in the next semester or whenever the courses are offered.
3. **The university will not charge any fees for registering the courses and also will not charge Examinations fees.**
4. The students staying in the **hostels need not have to pay any hostel fees during the period of condensed semester.** However, they have to bear the mess charges.
5. The Time Table of the classes and the examinations will be notified soon.
6. This is a one time relaxation which is given to the students. From the next regular semester of 2023-24, if they fail to maintain minimum of 75% attendance, again students will not be allowed to write the end semester examinations and there will not be any provision of condensed semester.

All the students are advised to take the benefit of the generosity and the gesture of the university administration and adhere to the guidelines strictly.
